What we will be learning in Years 1 and 2:

Year One

Religious Education - Our RE focus this term is "Resurrection" and "Miracles".

English- We will be studying the following books: 'Commotion in the Ocean', 'In the Rock Pool', 'Little Red' and 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea'.

Maths - In Maths we will be working on addition and subtraction within twenty; numbers to one hundred; partitioning numbers into tens and ones; halving and doubling and measuring capacity, mass and time.

Science - In Science we will be looking at Plants and will continue to explore Seasonal Changes.

History/Geography- Our Topic this term is "Oceans and Seas". We will be learning about our island home and the nations that it is made up of; seasides and coastal regions and making maps.

Art- Our art will be inspired by the work of Angela Haseltine Pozzi.

Music- Our music will be based around "Use Your Imagination". The children will continue to listen and appraise different styles of music and continue to work on rhythm and composition of music using the glockenspiels.

PE- We will be focussing on games in PE and with a coach from MUFC.

Year Two

Religious Education - Our RE focus this term is "Eastertide" and "The First Christians".

English- We will be studying the following books: "Flat Stanley", "Scaredy Squirrel", "Lost and Found" and "Follow the Moon Home."

Maths - In Maths we will be adding and subtracting 2digit numbers, solving problems using addition and subtraction, learning the 2, 5 and 10 times table.

Science - In Science we will be looking at Plants and what they need to grow well..

History/Geography - Our Topic this term is "Oceans and Seas". We will be learning about the five oceans and seven continents. We will compare two contrasting locations.

Art- Our art will be inspired by the work of James De Rosso.

Music- In music we will continue to compose our own short pieces of music and learn a song for the King's coronation, and a variety of songs by The Beatles.

PE - We will be focussing on gymnastics and doing outdoor games with a coach from MUFC.





Homework

Year 1:

We would like children to read at home each night. Please comment in your child's reading record book each time you read. In addition to reading, children will be sent home spellings to learn. It is important that these are practiced each night so that children are able to remember them.

Reading homework such as the alien words and/or phonics mats/booklets will also be sent home on a weekly basis.

Year 2:

Children will continue to take home the weekly reading and spelling booklet. Please ensure your child completes the activities in the booklet and learns the spelling list for that week. Please also ensure that your child reads their reading book regularly. The termly homework bingo grid will be sent home shortly.

Please do not send children in with backpacks or rucksacks as we do not have the space to store them. School book bags /PE bags are available from the office.

Reminders

<u>Arrive on time</u>: The soft start begins at **8:45am** and children should be in school by the latest of **8:55am**.
