E-Safety

This week we are focussing on safely setting up apps, games and software. In 2020, smartphone and tablet users spent a global total of around £330 million on downloading apps over the Christmas period. The following year, the UK alone saw almost seven million video games being given as gifts. The holiday season heralds a major spike in young people encountering new games and apps for the first time. Although games and apps mainly offer harmless fun, there are still risks to remain aware of – from realistic violence in this year's must-have shooter to contact from strangers on the latest networking platform.
