



The sessions are live, offering advice and tips on supporting all aspects of a child's development and school readiness.



Maths at St. Bernadette's



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Road Safety at St. Bernadette's

Children in Key Stage 2 have enjoyed participating in a Road Safety workshop. Class 6 went out into the community and had a go at using a speed gun to measure the speed of passing cars. They also tried on 'drunk goggles' to see how they impacted their judgements. Class 5 took part in the 'Crashed Vehicle Project' where they thought about the safety features of vehicles, made their own and then tested them to see how they would be affected by impact.
